**Disclosures**. Use this outline to compare benefits and premiums among policies.

**Premium Information**. Mountain Health Co-Op can only raise your premium if we raise the premium for all policies like yours in this state.

Read Your Policy Very Carefully. This is only an outline describing your policy's most important features. The policy is your insurance contract. You must read the policy itself to understand all of the rights and duties of both you and us.

**Right to Return Policy**. If you find that you are not satisfied with your policy, you may return it to us at our Medicare Supplement Administrative Office P.O. Box 2209 Duncan, OK 73534-2209. If you send the policy back to us within 30 days after you receive it, we will treat the policy as if it had never been issued and return all of your payments.

**Policy Replacement**. If you are replacing another health insurance policy, do NOT cancel it until you have actually received your new policy and are sure you want to keep it.

Exclusions. We will not pay for loss incurred while your policy is not in force, except as provided in the Extension of Benefits section of your policy; hospital or Skilled Nursing Facility confinement incurred during a Medicare Part A Benefit Period that begins while this policy is not in force; that portion of any Loss incurred which is paid for by Medicare; services for non-Medicare Eligible Expenses, including, but not limited to, routine exams, take-home drugs and eye refractions; services for which a charge is not normally made in the absence of insurance; or loss that is payable under any other Medicare supplement insurance policy or certificate.
